


ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY VALLEY, ARKANSAS


BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY VALLEY, ARKANSAS:

- Section 1. There is hereby created a Commission of the City of Cherry Valley, Arkansas, to be known as the "Cherry Valley Planning Commission," which said commission shall consist of 5 members who shall serve without compensation, and of whom not more than one-third may hold any other municipal office or appointment.
- Section 2. The Planning Commission shall have all the duties and functions authorized by Act 186 of the Acts of Arkansas 1957, as amended.
- Section 3. The members of the Planning Commission shall be named and appointed by the Mayor and such appointments will be valid and effective upon confirmation by the City Council.
- Section 4. The terms of the members of the Planning Commission shall be for 2 years. However, the initial appointments to the commission shall be 2 members 1 year terms 3 members 2 year terms. The Mayor shall designate the terms of the initial appointments. Thereafter, as vacancies occur in said Commission, for whatever cause, said vacancies shall be filled in the manner provided and said appointees shall hold office until expiration of the term which they were appointed to fill. All members of the Planning Commission whose terms may expire shall serve until their successors in office have been appointed and confirmed.
- Section 5. Emergency Clause. It is hereby found and declared that there is an urgent need for a Planning Commission for the City of Cherry Valley. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
